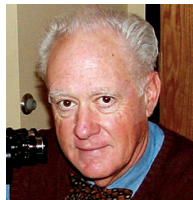


James Patterson, M.D., F.A.C.S.

James Patterson, MD completed medical school at the University of Colorado in 1981. After serving his medical internship year in Christchurch, New Zealand, he returned to the University of Colorado for his residency in Ophthalmology.

Since finishing residency, Dr. Patterson has been in practice with Colorado Ophthalmology Associates specializing in refractive surgery, cataract surgery and glaucoma surgery. He is board certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology and is an Assistant Clinical Professor of Ophthalmology at the University of Colorado. Dr. Patterson is a member and past president of the Colorado Society of Eye Physicians and Surgeons, and is a fellow in the American Academy of Ophthalmology, and American College of Surgeons.

Dr. Patterson has been performing refractive procedures since 1987. He started performing PRK and LASIK surgery in 1996 when it was first approved in the United States. He was one of the founding physicians of the Clear Vision Laser Centers in the Denver metro area.

Robert Keyser, MD completed medical school at the University of Michigan in 1968. Following medical school, he did a rotating internship at the University of Washington, Harborview Hospital. After two and one half years of service in the Navy as a Flight Surgeon he moved to Colorado where he did a residency in Ophthalmology at the University of Colorado.

Dr. Keyser specializes in refractive surgery, cataract surgery, glaucoma surgery and retinal laser surgery. He is board certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology since 1976, and is a Clinical Professor of Ophthalmology teaching the residents on a weekly basis at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center.

He returned to Denver and attended the University of Colorado School of Medicine and continued with his residency in Ophthalmology at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Center.

Dr. Ammons has been performing LASIK and PRK since 1996, when the first FDA approved excimer laser arrived in Denver. He also has an active cataract, glaucoma and general ophthalmology practice.

Dr. Ammons joined Colorado Ophthalmology Associates in 1993. He is a board certified member of the American Academy of Ophthalmology and is currently President Elect of the Colorado Society of Eye Physicians and Surgeons. Appointed by the Governor, he served, he served four years as a member of the Colorado Board of Medical Examiners, chairing panel A, before returning to dedicate full time to his ophthalmology practice.
